

Contract with God

The basis of this contract is my desire to honor God with my finances,
my faith in God and God's promises to bless the giver.

The nature of this contract is to give 10% of my income and additional seed-offerings to God's work this coming year. There is Biblical examples in Genesis 14:18-20 when Abraham committed to tithe and in Genesis 28:11-20 with Jacob's tithing vow. Just as you blessed these men with long life (Genesis 15:15), health (Genesis 25:7-8), prosperity (Genesis 13:2) and promotion (Genesis 24:1), I expect and ask for the same blessing.

Galatians 3:13-15 declares,

"Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith."

My contract with God is:

1. Made according to my faith (Mark 11:22–23).
2. An agreement between God and me.
3. Totally based upon God's promises in the Bible.
4. This also entitles me to not only rewards in this life, but also rewards eternally. (Mark 10:29–30).

I have the right to remind God in the courts of heaven of how he honored others and how he also has promised to honor me (Acts 10:34; Isaiah 43:26). This partnership with God has historical and Biblical precedence with other examples of those who made similar covenants with God.

They include:

1. Abraham's Covenant of Blessing (Genesis 12:2-3).
2. Isaac's obedience in sowing (Genesis 26:12–13).
3. The promises of blessings in Deuteronomy 1:11; Deuteronomy 8:18; Deuteronomy 28:1-14.
4. The transfer of wealth according to Proverbs 13:22 and examples of wealth transferred during the times of Joseph, Moses and Solomon.
5. Nehemiah's blessing in rebuilding the city of Jerusalem (Nehemiah 2:20).
6. The blessings to believers who give, fast and pray (Isaiah 58 and 2 Chronicles 20:20).
7. The covenant of tithing (Malachi 3:8–12).
8. The blessing of Jesus in Matthew 6:33 and Luke 6:38.
9. The revelation of prosperity and abundance given to the apostle Paul in 2 Corinthians 8:9, Galatians 3:13–15, Philippians 4:13–19.
